Swimming Teacher – Job Description

As a swimming teacher working with Super Swim Academy, you will be required to help people of all ages and abilities to develop swimming skills and techniques, and to exercise in water.

As a Swimming teacher with Super Swim Academy you will be required:

- To teach customers of Super Swim Academy to Swim in one to one or in group classes
- To plan and deliver classes from beginner level to an advanced standard dependent upon; your qualifications, the level of the swimmer and the needs of Super Swim Academy
- To provide explanations and demonstrate swimming techniques in the water
- To correct swimming techniques and identify ways to improve performance
- To carry out assessments and complete assessment records for children during week 8 lessons of the 10 week course programs
- To monitor and maintain all Health & Safety requirements for teaching children swimming in line with STA standards.
- To check that life-saving equipment is in full working order
- To deal with minor injuries and accidents
- To continue your professional development by ensuring you are up to date with STA standard qualifications.

You may already hold a current STA or ASA swimming teacher's award or you may wish to undertake your STA accredited qualification through 'Super Swim Academy's - Teacher Training Program'. In some cases Super Swim Academy may fund training for new teachers, (conditions will apply). You must be 17 years old or above to undertake STA teacher training awards. Contact us for further information with regards to our Teacher Training Program.

To work with children or other vulnerable people you will be required to have clearance from the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS). You can apply for this through Super Swim Academy or through the Home Office website. Our Teacher Training Program involves practical sessions in the water working with youngsters, therefore, you will not be permitted to undertake any training or employment with Super Swim Academy, until clearance from the DBS has been received.
