Our swimming teachers often work evenings and on occasion weekends during term time only and holidays are required to be taken during non-term time. Some flexibility may be required with this as we occasionally run "crash courses" for students during some school holidays. Rotas and availability will be discussed with the individual teachers prior to being allocated sessions.

To work with children or other vulnerable people you will need clearance from the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS), which you can apply for through Super Swim Academy or through the Home Office website. Our teacher training involves practical sessions in the water working with youngsters so you will not be permitted to undertake the training or employment with Super Swim Academy, until clearance from the DBS has been received.
